

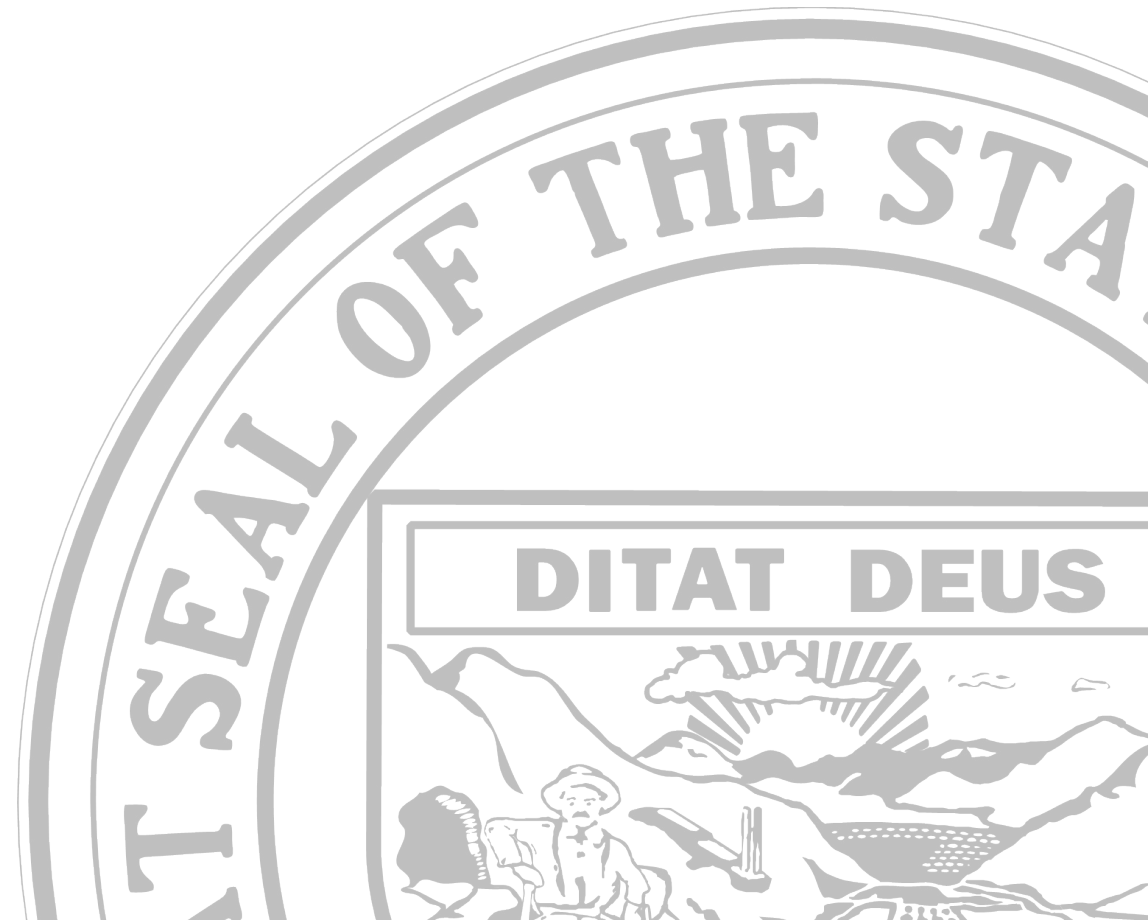

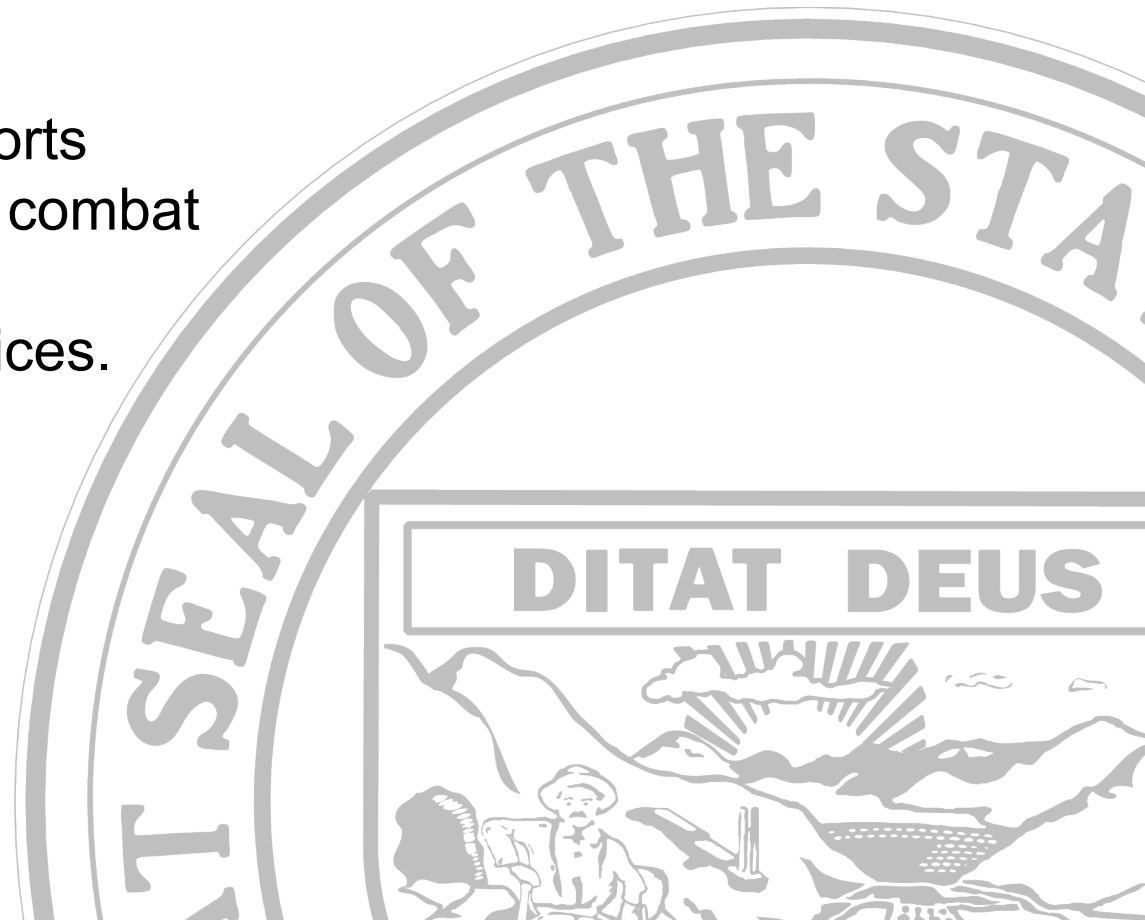

2023 STOP RFGA Overview

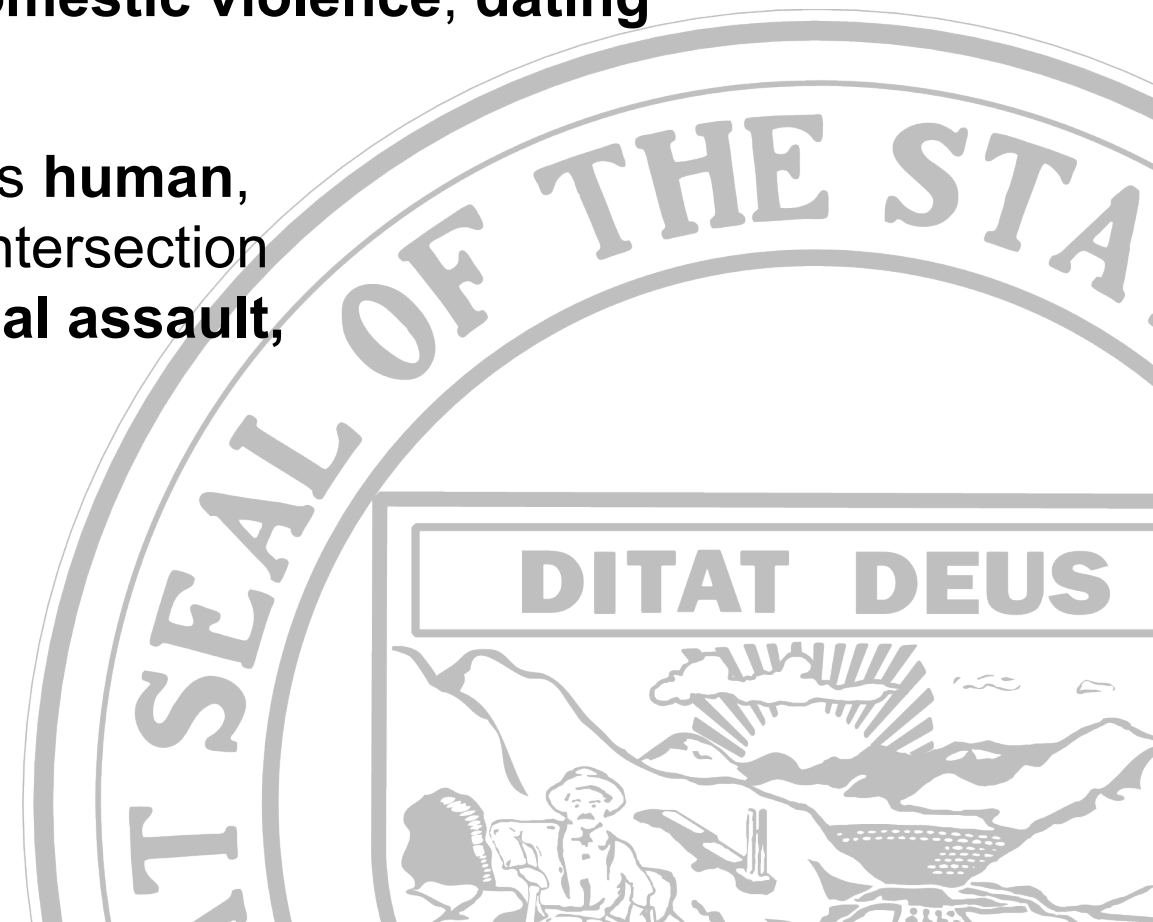
\$3.3 million awarded to programs across Arizona

Arizona STOP Grant Program supports victim-serving organizations, courts, law enforcement, and prosecution to address **domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking.**

The STOP Grant Program is also able to address **human, sex, and labor trafficking** in which there is an intersection with **domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking.**

Arizona Department of Child Safety (DCS)

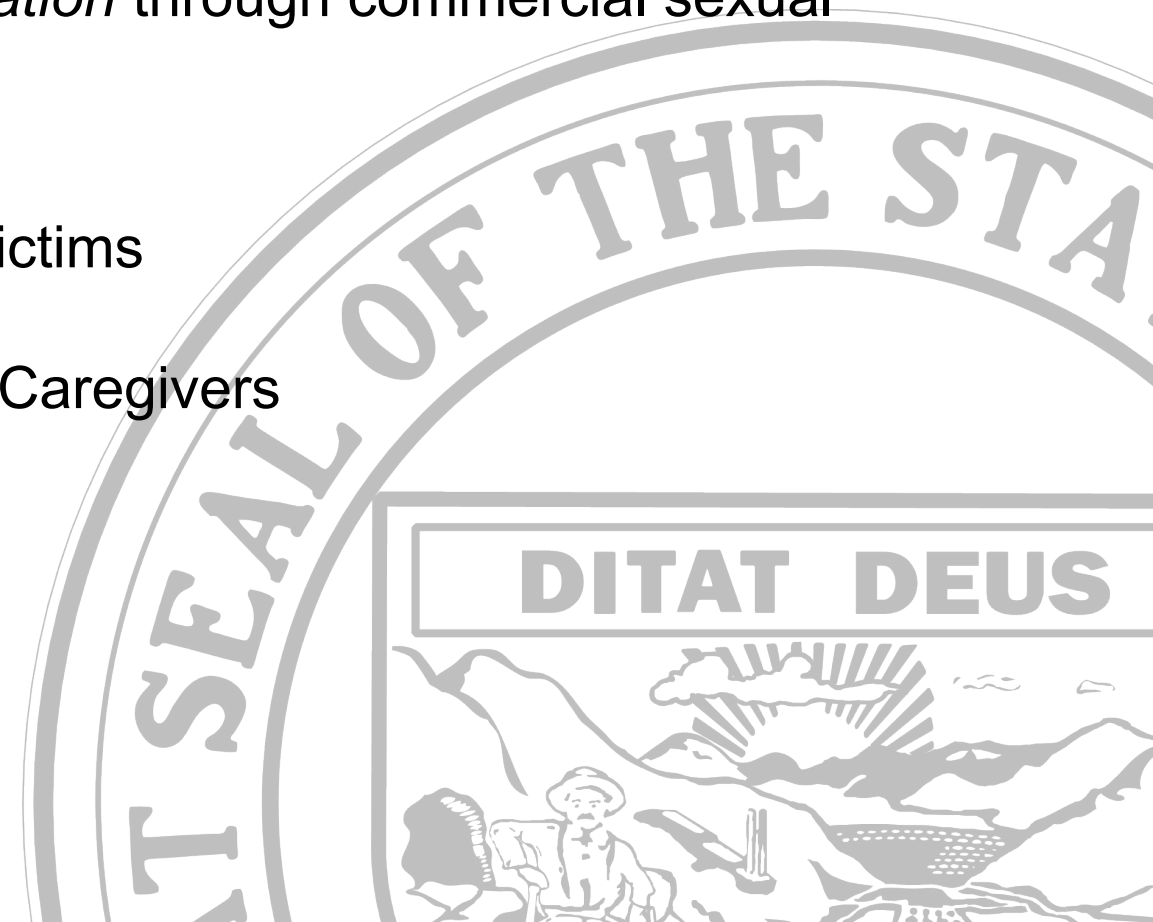
Educate and enable DCS staff to proactively support individuals in out-of-home care with *confirmed, suspected and/or risk of victimization* through commercial sexual exploitation.

Arizona State University Sex Trafficking Intervention Research (ASU STIR)

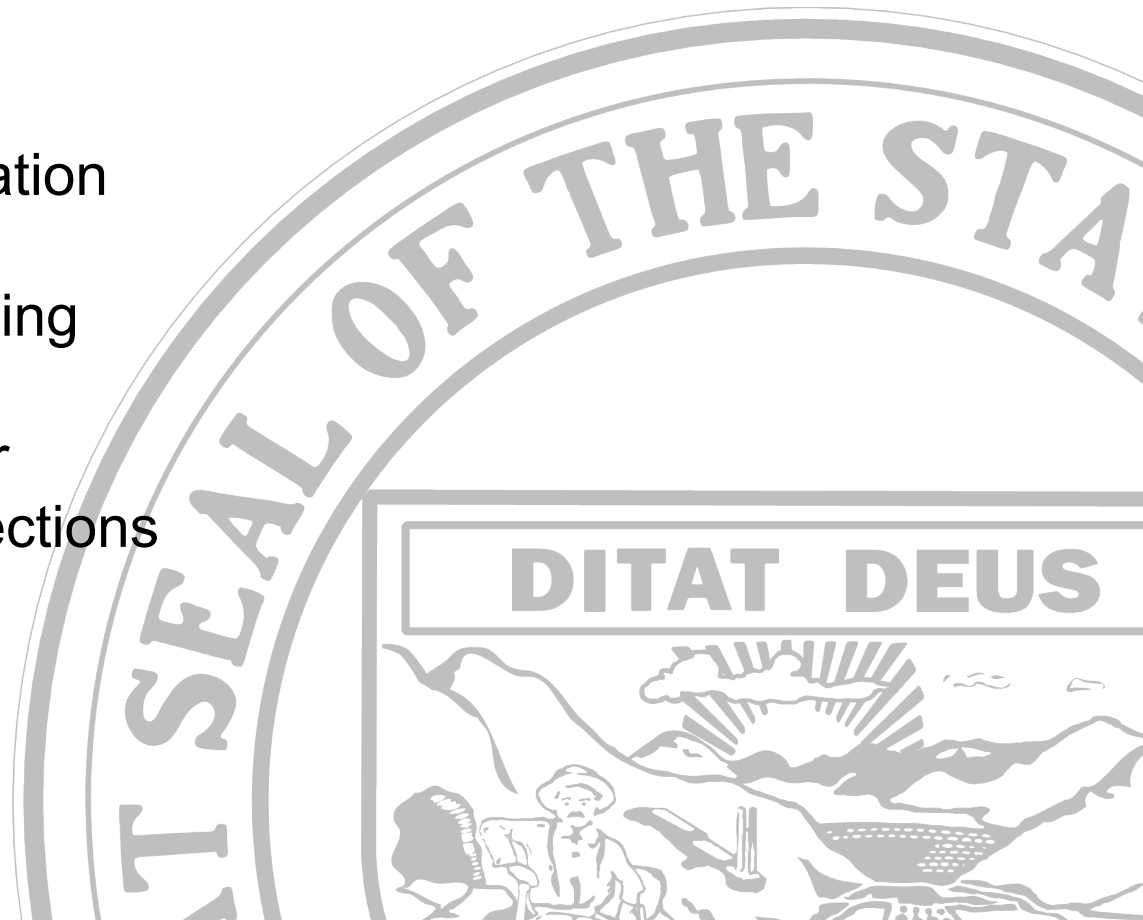
Provide sex trafficking training across Arizona to build capacity to identify and provide services in urban and rural communities.

Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County

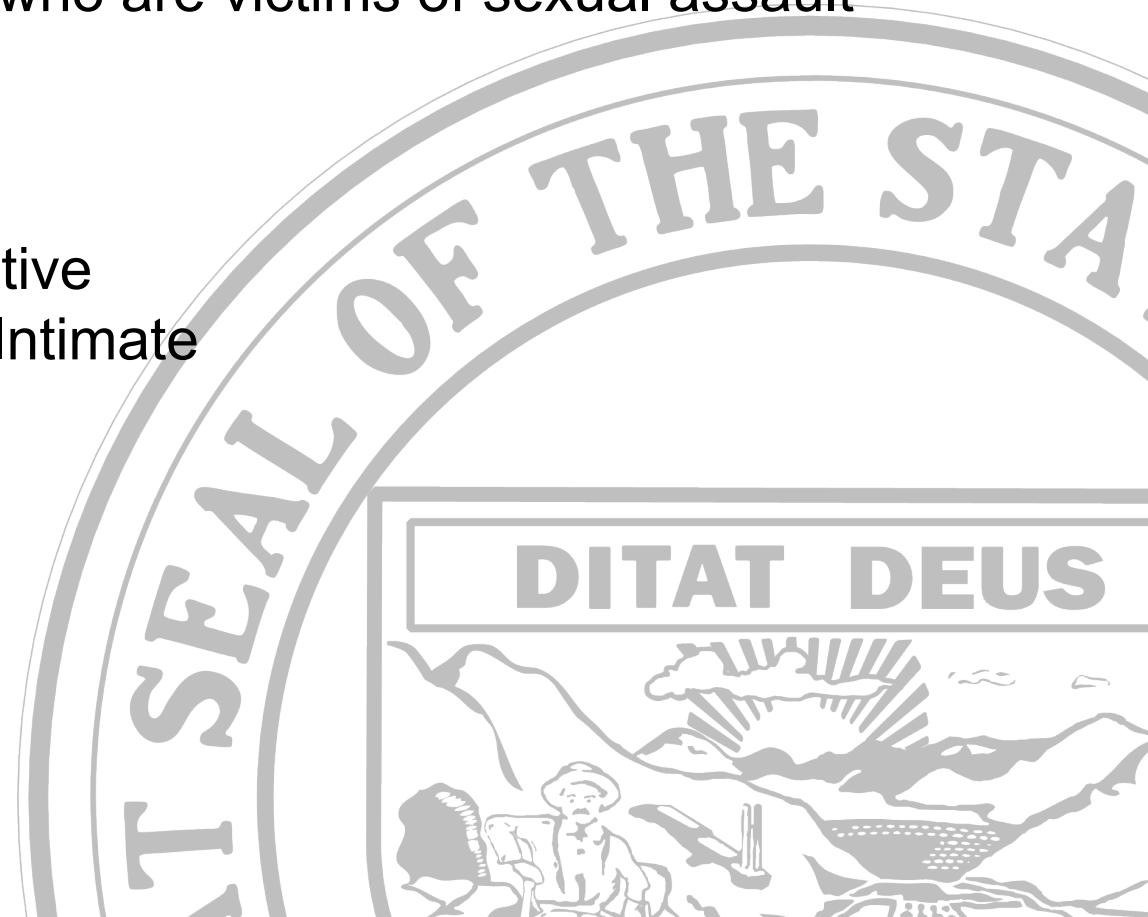
