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Arizona Alzheimer's Task Force

- ► Launched in 2010
- Statewide Effort soliciting input from over 500 stakeholders and engaged more than 100 community organizations
- ▶ 2015 A State Plan is Born

Senior Action Days

Community and Legislative Partners in Aging

- ▶ In 2016, GACA identified a need for a bipartisan workgroup
- 2017 Initially called "Senior Caucus"
- Later name changed to CLPA

Virtual Dementia Tours

- Supporting the Arizona Alzheimer's State Plan
- ► Partnered with Western Arizona Council of Governments Area Agency on Aging to train professionals in non-health care fields
- Exceeded Goals set for Training
- ▶ 97% success rate

Statewide Representation

- Council Members selected Statewide
- ► Focus on Education, Training, Advocacy and Events serving Older Arizonans
- Sponsorship/Participation in Aging Organizations Events and Legislative Mandates

Arizona Senate Bill 1172

- ► Family Caregiver Reimbursement Program
- Reimburse Family Caregivers for qualifying expenses for home modifications and assistive care technology to enable their qualified family member to be mobile, safe, and independent to avoid institutional care
